### Preparation of Manuscripts

Each submission should include two title pages. The first title page should include (1) *paper title*, (2) *author name(s)*, (3) *affiliation(s)*, (4) *address(es)*, (5) *e-mail address(es)*, and (6) *telephone number(s)*. The correspondence author should be indicated. The second title page should include the paper title, an abstract of 150-200 words, and 4 to 6 keywords. The manuscript should be double-spaced throughout. Tables, figures and a brief biography of each author should appear at the end of the text. The location of tables and figures in the body of the manuscript should be indicated. References should be listed alphabetically, with name and year cited in text (Refer to the Publication Manual of APA 6th Edition for details). Authors should submit their manuscripts in MS Word format via email attachment directly to either the Editor-in-Chief or the Associate Editor or [journal@icisa.info](mailto:journal@icisa.info). Articles could be theoretical research studies, empirical or survey studies, literature and research reviews providing new perspectives, studies based on a synergy of research proffering models, comparative studies, or case studies. All manuscripts will be reviewed through a double-blind review process. The review process normally takes about 6-8 weeks to finish. To be considered for the upcoming issue of the journal, submissions must be received by **July 10, 2016**.
