Currently, he served as an Associate Editor of Information & Management and an Area Editor of Journal of Information Management.

She-I Chang is a Professor and the Chair of the Department of Accounting and Information Technology, National Chung Cheng University (CCU), Taiwan. He received his PhD degree in Information Systems Management from Queensland University of Technology (QUT), Australia. He has also received several students' thesis supervision awards and best paper awards from various competitions. The three ERP textbooks edited by She-I have been widely used at universities in Taiwan.

The Director – Advisory : *Dr. Houn-Gee Chen*

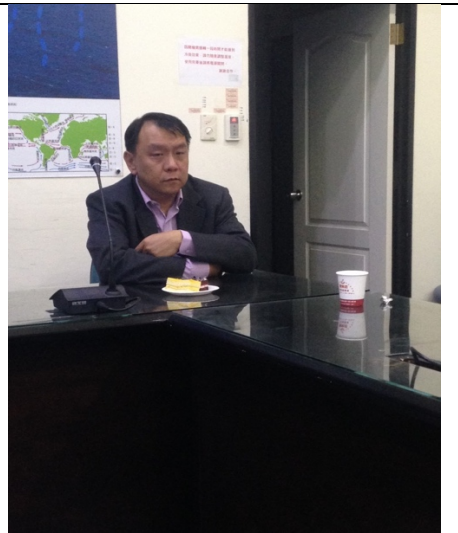
